Neatly written, organized, and presentable, (i.e. frayed edges of notebook paper has been removed, pages are not folded or bent, stapled when necessary)
Good Work	Handed in on time	Every question has been attempted and full work is shown. No questions were left blank.	Many of the questions may be answered incorrectly, but no more than half.	Proper heading	Neatly written, organized, and still presentable, but not stapled or notebook edges have <u>not</u> been removed
Poor Work	Incomplete or Late; this includes assignments handed in the same day after the students assigned class period	Questions have been left blank. Little to no work is shown	More than half the questions are answered incorrectly	Incomplete heading	Solutions are completed messily and/or disorganized.
No Credit	Never handed in or handed in extremely late	Many or a majority of the questions were left blank, regardless if the completed questions are corrected or incorrect.	Student submitted work that has been copied/plagiarized or was not completed on his/her own.	No heading or is missing a name	Completed illegibly or solutions were unclear
